GARDENS OF SECRET DELIGHTS

Among the more than 30 great and small projects within *In & Out of Paris* are Vaux-le-Vicomte, Versailles, and Courances—all classic André Le Nôtre-style French gardens. Also discover the Paris gardens of celebrated artist Jean-Michel Othoniel and art aficionado Pierre Bergé, architect Kenzō Takada's Japanese retreat in the Bastille, Australian couturier Martin Grant's tiny terrace in the Marais, Mexican painter MariCarmen Hernandez's Montmartre rooftop, and American architect Michael Herrman's homage to Le Corbusier's surreal Champs-Élysées garden for bon vivant Charles de Beistegui.

Modern masters Louis Benech, Gilles Clement, Pascal Cribier, Christian Fournet, Camille Muller, Hugues Peuvergne, and Pierre-Alexandre Risser are also featured, representing a new era of experiments, color, and asymmetry in the Paris garden.



Frank Lloyd Wright's buildings on the West Coast have not been thoroughly covered in print until now. Between 1909 and 1959, Wright designed a total of 36 structures up and down the West Coast, from Seattle to Southern California. These include well-known structures such as the Marin County Civic Center and Hollyhock House in Los Angeles, and many lesser-known gems such as the 1909 Stewart House near Santa Barbara.

With nearly 200 photographs by veteran architectural photographer Joel Puliatti and 44 archival images (many of which have never been seen in print before), this comprehensive survey of Wright's West Coast legacy features background information on the clients' relationships with Wright, including insights gleaned from correspondence with the original owners and interviews with many of the current owners.

MARK ANTHONY WILSON is an architectural historian who has been writing and teaching about architecture for more than 35 years. He has written four previous books about architecture, including *Julia Morgan: Architect of Beauty* and *Bernard Maybeck: Architect of Elegance*. He lives in Berkeley, California.

Then come the luscious recipes for classic French soups—this pistou, onion, cheese with croutons, vegetable, salt cod and potato, roasted tomato, and lentil. There are recipes for delicate consommés as well as a plethora of creamy soups—corn, mushroom, chestnut, oyster, and fresh pea. Rounding out the selection are hearty stews—Beef Bourguignon, Cassoulet, Pot Roast, and Fruity Curried Lamb Stew. Not to be missed are the delightful cold soups—vichyoisse with asparagus, cantaloupe, and cold red pepper. All are prepared in classic French style but with Ms. Herrick's creative twists on familiar French offerings.
