Susan Wener survived cancer not once, but twice. The first time, she followed the traditional route of surgery and chemotherapy. The second time, she went renegade, stepping out into the field of alternative medicine. She reminds us that irrespective of circumstance, life is filled with endless possibility, that hope and wishful thinking not only help us keep our heads above water during difficult times but are essential to our sanity, and that what makes us magic is our will and ability to pick ourselves up every time we fall.

Susan Wener is an educator, guide, and teacher to people coping with life threatening illnesses. She holds a degree in teaching from McGill University, and is also a Natural Health Consultant with a certification in Multi-dimensional Healing. She is a practicing member of the Canadian Association of Naturopaths, and has been a member of the Canadian Guidance and Counseling Association since the mid-1990s. She also holds a Master Practitioner Certification in Neuro-Linguistic Programming, Time Line Therapy, and Hypnosis with world-renowned Master Trainer, Dr. Tad James. Susan shares her knowledge by speaking at educational institutions, at conferences, and on the radio. She is also an active participant on the Board of Governors at the Jewish General Hospital, The Board of Hope and Cope (an organization addressing the needs of cancer patients and their families), and is a Natural Health Consultant on the Gynecological Oncology Tumor Board of the Jewish General Hospital. 

Works On Paper

DALE CROES, SUSAN POINT AND GARY WYATT

A gorgeous collection of prints by one of the Northwest's leading artists.

Over the past thirty years Susan Point has become the preeminent Coast Salish artist of her generation, exploring many different modern and traditional themes in a wide variety of media. She has received major public commissions in her home province of British Columbia as well as throughout the Northwest coast, the traditional territory of her people, creating extraordinary monumental sculptures that grace important public buildings. Her glass sculptures are collected around the world. This is the first book devoted exclusively to her works on paper. Over the past thirty years Point has been an innovator in printmaking, adapting traditional Coast Salish themes to modern art techniques, translating the heritage of her culture to the wider world while creating a body of work that appeals to art collectors from around the globe. Her synthesis of contemporary and traditional styles has resulted in a formidable artistic accomplishment. This beautifully designed volume collects 160 of her prints together for the first time and is sure to inspire and amaze those who see it.

NOTES

Susan A. Point is a Coast Salish artist from the Musqueam Band. Musqueam is situated on the banks near the mouth of the Fraser River, within what is now metropolitan Vancouver. She has immersed herself in the study of traditional Coast Salish art and culture and emerged with a language of design both authentic and vibrantly contemporary in nature. Her works can now be found worldwide. Dale Croes received his Ph.D. from Washington State University, and continues as an Adjunct Faculty. He specializes in archaeological excavations of well-preserved wood/fiber artifacts from Northwest waterlogged/wet sites. He has published books and over 50 articles on sites he has excavated, including the Ozette, Hoko River, Sunken Village and Qwu?gwes. He lives in Olympia, Washington. Gary Wyatt is one of Canada's foremost experts on art of the Northwest Coast and the co-owner of Spirit Wrestler Gallery, Vancouver's leading gallery of First Nations art. He lives in Vancouver.






