Dear Family,

I turned fifty years old this past November. For the first time in six years, all of our nine children gathered together at our California home to celebrate Thanksgiving and my birthday. One son is in the Army. Two others have been living in Argentina, Uruguay, Brazil, and the Netherlands over the past four years. And now they and a younger brother are all in college, living in the same apartment together (which can be good and bad). Five are still home but frequently off doing something. While it's never boring, it's getting harder and harder to have our family together to celebrate events, share our diverse lives and interests, and catch up on what is happening.

It seems like only yesterday that each of these children was a newborn baby needing help every minute. Now most are grown and living lives of their own (with much financial help, I might add). How has the time gone by so quickly? More and more I'm finding I understand the words of an ancient prophet who wrote "... our lives passed away like as it were unto us a dream. ..." Things move quickly as we get older.

I'm grateful for my experiences in raising nine children. I said to my wife, Michele, this week that I don't really have many regrets as a parent. Sure, I wish we had gone on more vacations, but we did vacation. We've canyoneered Zion National Park, rock climbed cliffs from Utah to Idaho, backpacked the Tetons, the Wind Rivers, the Uintas, and the John Muir trail. We've climbed the tallest mountain in the lower 48, canoed to the largest lake west of the continental divide, visited museums, listened to chamber music in New York, gone to Disneyland and Disney World, surfed, scuba dived, and much more. We've been blessed. We had nightly dinner as a family, read *The Lord of the Rings* trilogy together, out loud, for a year, worked on five different Eagle Scout projects, and learned multiple musical instruments together. It's been and continues to be an adventure. So, no regrets.

But I did say to Michele, "I wish I had been more patient at times." And I also wish I didn't worry so much. Perhaps those go hand in hand. As I look at this list of books that celebrate so much for families to discover together, I want to trust more in the innate goodness that comes from listening to our hearts and not worry so much about what my children did or didn't do. This is a tall order for a type A personality, but I believe that at fifty I may be ready for a new adventure—letting people move toward destinations of their own choosing and not so much my own.
