



American Fix

Inside the Opioid Addiction Crisis - and How to End It

Nearly every American knows someone who has been affected by the opioid epidemic, or has been directly affected themselves. Addiction is a trans-partisan issue that impacts individuals from every walk of life, and it is being fueled by a powerful pharmaceutical industry with a direct financial interest in encouraging the abuse of prescription painkillers. Millions of Americans, tired of watching their loved ones die while politicians ignore this issue, offering platitudes instead of plans, are asking themselves: Where is the solution? Where is the hope? *Where's the outrage?*

Enter Ryan Hampton, a young man who has made addiction reform his life's mission. Through his wildly successful organization Facing Addiction, Hampton has quickly emerged as the de facto thought leader of the national recovery movement. As a recovering addict himself, he understands firsthand how easy it is to develop a dependency on opioids, and how destructive that dependency quickly becomes. Now, he is waging a permanent campaign to change our way of thinking about and addressing addiction in this country. In *American Fix*, Hampton discusses his own struggle with addiction, outlines the challenges that the recovery movement currently faces, and offers a concrete plan of action towards making opioid dependency a thing of the past.




